Dear Director Giles:

On February 7<sup>th</sup>, Concerned Citizens for Cowichan Lodge, and the Duncan United Church - Social Justice and Outreach Committee, co-sponsored a public forum at the Duncan United Church.

The purposes of that forum were to discuss the current status of Cowichan Lodge and our concerns for its future, and to explore the concept of Healthcare Cooperatives as it might apply to that facility.

As you are aware, at the end of June 2008, the Vancouver Island Health Authority abruptly announced the imminent closure of Cowichan Lodge. Immediate public protest resulted in the granting of a Stay Order and the subsequent winning of an Appeal against the two-month closure decision. As a result, Cowichan Lodge is still open, with 13 seniors currently residing there. However, V.I.H.A. has stated that it will be closed at the end of August 2009. In the interim, V.I.H.A. is refusing to place any short-term or long-term patients or residents there, inspite of the increasing need of such placements in our community.

Our community still strongly protests the closure of Cowichan Lodge. We feel that it is a valuable, viable, and vital public health-care resource for our community. We also feel that the seniors who live there have the right to live out their days undisturbed in their Cowichan Lodge home.

During the February 7<sup>th</sup> forum we presented a Resolution to the gathered public Resolution. If you

By way of the Resolution, we urge the C.V.R.D. to immediately request the Vancouver Island Health Authority to meet with representatives of Cowichan Valley stakeholder groups, to discuss and plan for the maintenance, continued viability and future of Cowichan Lodge.
