

AREA F MINUTES FOR OCTOBER 1, 2015

MSC: Ray will look into the cost for replacement of 2 or 3 trees for Central Park in Honeymoon Bay. Dave Darling, Thor.

MSC: Commission will give direction to staff to proceed with pruning and maintenance of trees in Memory Lane in Honeymoon Bay. Ray, David L.

Brian: CVRD will give us options re playground at Central Park.

Dave: Commission will meet with community at Honeymoon Bay with these options to see what they want.

Brian: CVRD will arrange to fix the float at Bear Lake Park.

Thor: Picnic table at Mayo Creek needs to be repaired and painted and please install trash can.
