CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Are you passionate about waste management? The CVRD is amending the Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan) and needs qualified individuals and members of the public to be part of a public advisory committee (PAC) commencing March 2018. The PAC will advise the CVRD on matters related to solid waste management planning including design of the public consultation process, development of guiding principles and review of technical reports.

Up to 17 people will participate in the PAC for a term of up to two years, or until Plan submission. Members should strive to keep abreast of solid waste management issues both locally and in a broader, regional context. Membership will be balanced between technical and non-technical members and between industry/private sector and public members.

If you are interested in being considered, submit a nomination by **4:30 p.m. on Monday, March 5, 2018** to Tauseef Waraich, Manager, Recycling & Waste Management, at es@cvrd.bc.ca. Nominations should be no more than one page in length and must include full name and address, professional designations (if any) and a brief description outlining your background and interest in solid waste management. REGIONAL GRANTS-IN-AID - DEADLINE EXTENSION

2018 Application Process

The Cowichan Valley Regional District (CVRD) has extended its deadline to March 23 and is again accepting submissions from qualified organizations for Regional Grants-in-Aid for 2018. To qualify, an organization must be a non-profit organization that is incorporated under the laws of British Columbia, Canada. Organizations must be community based, providing a service that benefits the residents of the region, and whose efforts are regional in nature.

Organizations applying for Regional Grant-in-Aids must also provide a description of the project, event or service for which funding is requested; the beneficiaries of the project, event or service; and the total cost of the project, event or service etc. in order to have its application considered.
