Cowichan transit services recommence fee collection, front door boarding

DUNCAN, BC – Beginning today, fare collection and front door boarding will resume in all BC Transit communities, including the Cowichan Valley Commuter (CVC), local transit, and handyDART services.

During the week of June 1 - June 7, monthly passes from March, 2020 and January – April, 2020 semester passes will continue to be accepted as methods of payment.
