### **Fall 2020 Recreation Guide now online, new registration procedures in place**

**DUNCAN, BC** – While recreation centres and programming are once again available to the public, the Cowichan Valley Regional District has established new procedures to support the well-being and safety of all patrons and facility staff.

The [CVRD Fall Recreation Guide](#) is now available online, but due to COVID-19 no printed copies will be published this year. The CVRD has also created a new '[how-to](#)' guide for online recreation program registration, and pre-registration for drop-in programs to assist resident participation in the current service offerings at all CVRD recreation facilities.

All CVRD arenas are now open, with some building entrance restrictions and new [safety protocols and guidelines](#) in place. These safety guidelines are continually updated in response to provincial health and safety recommendations, and therefore users are asked to check the CVRD website before attending a recreation centre and/or program.

One notable change is that drop-in Public Skating has been replaced by online pre-registration at all three CVRD ice arenas.
